The process of SLIT (and SCIT) immunotherapy both desensitize the body allowing it to understand that these every day allergens are not harmful foreign invaders which it must defend itself from through inflammation. Inflammation which then materializes in the nasal passages (stuffy nose), eyes (watery & itchy), sinuses (sinus headaches or infections), ear canals (ear infections), lungs (asthma), or skin (dermatitis or eczema).
